

Fundación César Manrique



The César Manrique Foundation is a 20min drive away. It is the most important place to visit to learn more about the island's famous son.

César Manrique's talent and passion for the environment is seen throughout this museum, from the art hung on the walls, to the architecture and open spaces.

Fardín del Cactus



The last intervention work from César Manrique is the cactus garden built inside an ancient quarry, that is home to over 450 species of cactus from all five continents.


Mirador del Río



Located 400 metres high, on the Risco de Famara, the Mirador del Río is one of César Manrique's most representative architectural creations as it shows a series of artistic and architectural details which combine art and nature. There is an exceptional view of the Chinijo Archipelago through a large glass window, as you take a coffee and pastry in the café.

Lagomar




Lagomar was conceived by César Manrique and designed by the artist Jesús Soto. Now a museum, it is located atop a red mountain in the small town of Nazaret. It is carved out of the rock face and blends perfectly with the nature that surrounds it. It is a most unique and remarkable architectural creation.

Cueva de los Verdes



The volcanic eruption of Mount Corona resulted in the formation of a lava tube, which has become one of the wonders of Lanzarote:

Cueva de los Verdes. This place also serves as a concert venue. Look out for concert dates, as this is a most memorable experience.


Jameos del agua



César Manrique created Jameos del Agua inside the remains of a lava tube formed by the volcanic eruption of mount Corona. Following all the natural forms, the free flowing spaces define this singular and exceptional example of organic architecture that is also home to an endemic blind crab. In addition, Jameos del Agua features a restaurant, bar and auditorium. Concerts and cultural events take place all year round.

Every Tuesday and Thursday enjoy live performances from 10 pm. until 12:30 am.

Casa-Museo del Campesino



Located in San Bartolomé, Casa-Museo del Campesino is a public tribute César Manrique paid to the hardships faced by men and women working the fields to bring the land to life after the volcanic eruptions. This space showcases traditional architecture, agriculture, handicraft and gastronomy. The complex is guarded by the Monumento a la Fecundidad (Fertility Monument), a 15-metre-tall avant-garde sculpture.

La Geria



The breath-taking landscape of La Geria is home the majority of Lanzarote's wine production. The black lava rocks and gravel (known as picón) protect and irrigate the vines. The black surface collects the dew which feeds the plants. There are several award-winning wineries located in La Geria. They offer guided tours and tastings. All the wines in this region are excellent, The grape variety typically is Malvasía Volcánica, which is elaborated from an indigenous variety of grape of the same name.



Volcán del Cuervo



The Volcán del Cuervo or Volcano of the Raven, erupted in 1730 and is one of the most popular to visit due to its dramatic look and easy access.

After an easy 5-km trail one can take a look inside its crater and see the amazing colors and textures. It is located in Tinajo, near La Geria.



Parque Nacional de Timanfaya




Timanfaya National Park

Formed by volcanic eruptions between 1730 and 1736, the national park also known as Fire Mountains. The lunar landscape is captivating. Take the free bus around the park and learn about its origins and how Lanzarote and its people survived the violent eruptions. You will visit over 20 craters on a sea of lava of almost 200 square metres.

We recommend visiting in between 9am and 11am or 3pm and 4:45pm to avoid long lines.

Salinas del Janubio



Located in the southern part of the island, between Yaiza and Playa Blanca, these colorful salt lakes surrounded by black sand beaches create a stunning picture. Sunsets are truly amazing as the colors of the sky change the surface of the salt flats creating unique images. The salt flats are a working operation, still producing pure natural sea-salt which can be purchased locally.



Los Hervideros



A few minutes drive from Salinas de Janubio you find 'Los Hervideros' or 'the kettles'. A series of blow-holes and stunning coastal erosion formations. The dramatic coastline is particularly popular at sunset.


You can often find lava stone, embedded with the semi precious stone 'Olivin'.



Charco de los Clicos o Charco Verde



This green lagoon is named after a now extinct shellfish species named clicos. Its second name comes from the intense green color of its waters which is due to algae. The unique lagoon has been carved from wind and sea erosion. The site has been used in the movies like 'Los Abrazos Rotos' (Broken Embraces) by Pedro Almodóvar or 'In the Heart of the Sea' by Ron Howard.

Towns & Villages

Haría



This little town is located in the area commonly known as the valley of a thousand palms, on the northeastern part of Lanzarote. Haría is the greenest area in Lanzarote and has the coolest weather. There is a market every Saturday on the main street with locally grown produce and artisan crafts. You can walk around the narrow streets and enjoy the slow pace of life. There are walking trails from the village leading up to the highest peaks.



La Villa de Teguise



The small, 15th-century town of Teguise is the old capital of Lanzarote, and colonial mansions still line its cobbled streets. Points of interest are: Museo de la Piratería (Pirate Museum), Santa Bárbara castle; Casa Mueso del Timple (Timple—a traditional canarian instrument similar to a ukelele), the historic Church of Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe; and the Convento de San Francisco. Every Sunday, from gam until 2pm the village hosts the largest and most popular market in the Canary Islands with over 400 stalls it is a mix of food, artisan crafts and fancy goods.



Caleta de Famara



Famara is a playground for the free spirited and for those who enjoy the 'surf'.

This small town is home to one of the most spectacular beaches in Spain, and some of the most amazing surfing waves. Enjoy delicious fresh food at the water's edge, take a surf lesson or just take a stroll down the beautiful beach. This is a real world apart.



Yaiza



The charming village of Yaiza is located in the south of Lanzarote. Find heritage gems among the traditional white houses of Yaiza like the Casa de la Cultura Benito Pérez Armas, a house museum with lowering balcony gardens and green wooden staircases; or the 17th-century Church of Nuestra Señora de los Remedios.

Beaches

Papagayo



This beach was named the best Spanish beach of 2019 by Condé Nast Traveler magazine. It is located in Playa Blanca, on the south coast of Lanzarote.

The crystal waters and hidden white sandy coves make for a perfect day of relaxation and water activities.



Fablillo



Playa Jablillo is located in Costa Teguise, the 2nd largest resort. Due to the manmade boulder barrier across the bay it is a perfect spot to snorkel or swim. The calm and clear waters make it easy to spot a variety of fish.



Playa Grande



With 1,200 meters of fine sand and clear, shallow waters, Playa Grande, in Puerto del Carmen is one of the largest beaches in Lanzarote and has all kinds of services and amenities.




Famara



Located in the coastal town of Caleta de Famara, this beach is the surfers capital, and has over 5 km of sand overlooked by the steep cliffs of Risco de Famara, the remains of a caldera.

You can enjoy a variety of surfing related sports here. The conditions are excellent. Walking the beach is a favourite for all, Sunsets here are truly stunning, and deserve photographing.



Caletón Blanco



In the north east part of Lanzarote, close to the fishing village of Órzola, there is a series of stunning coves. Caletón Blanco is the largest and most accessible. The name 'Caletón Blanco' (White Cove) comes from its immaculate white sand. In some areas, especially at low tide, you will find natural shallow lagoons, making it an ideal location for children or those who prefer calm water.



Playa del Risco




This unspoiled beach lies at the bottom of the cliffs at Famara. The only way to reach it is either by boat, or by hiking down the Camino de los Gracioseros (Gracioceros Trail). This trekking route starts at a high of 600 meters above sea level and it is a 4 km route of average to high difficulty. The hike is predominantly volcanic rocks which can be slippery at times, so sturdy walking shoes are advised.



Playa de Las Conchas



Playa de las Conchas or Shell Beach is located in the north-west of the island of La Graciosa, accessed from Lanzarote via ferry from the port of Orzóla. This unspoilt sandy beach is on the other side of the island and is akin to the carribean. You can walk to this beach, hire a bike, or catch a jeep taxi. The deep blue waters, and volcanic backdrop are stunning, but there is always a strong current, so swimming isn't advised. You have a clear view of Montaña Clara and Alegranza, the other islands which make up the Chinijo Archipelago.



Playa de La Cocina



Also, in La Graciosa, another popular beach is Playa de la Cocina (Kitchen Beach). This little cove is at the foot of the stunning Montaña Amarilla (Yellow Mountain) which provides shelter from the wind. The way to reach it is either by taking an hour walk along the coast, or by a 25-minute bike ride. You can also hire a taxi to short the distance, but you will still have to walk.
